

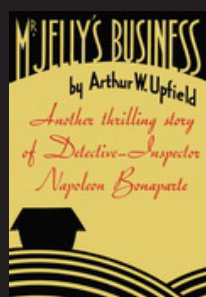
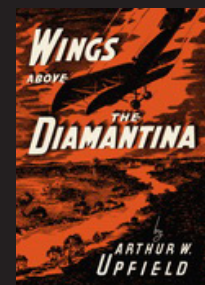
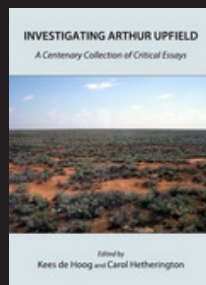

**Kees de Hoog** received his BSc and MBA degrees from the University of Western Australia. He maintains the *Arthur Upfield: Creator of "Bony"* Internet site, and has published three anthologies of Upfield's short works, two of his non-Bony novels, and two related books.

**Carol Hetherington** was formerly the Manager of the Bibliographic Information Service within *AustLit: The Australian Literature Resource*, and is an Editorial Assistant for *Australian Literary Studies*. Carol writes in the field of publishing history.

**Professor Peter Spearritt** (Chair) is Professor of History at The University of Queensland and Director of the Centre for the Government of Queensland. He is the author of numerous works on history and culture, including *The Sydney Harbour Bridge: A Life*.
