



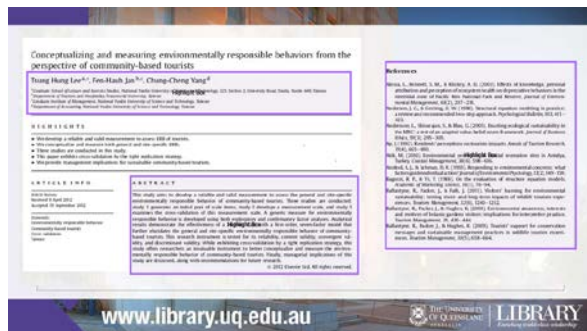


Peer Reviewed Articles

<p>Slide 1</p> 	<p>In this tutorial you'll discover what 'peer reviewed' means and learn how to find peer reviewed articles.</p>
<p>Slide 2</p> 	<p><i>"My lecturer said I need to use peer reviewed journals! What are they?"</i></p>
<p>Slide 3</p> 	<p>'Peer reviewed' means that the articles submitted to these journals are put through a review and approval process before they are accepted for publication.</p> <p>This process is carried out by a panel of experts to ensure that the research described in the articles meets the highest standards.</p>
<p>Slide 4</p> 	<p>Lecturers often recommend the use of peer reviewed journals because they contain the latest research and high quality scholarship.</p> <p>Sometimes the term 'refereed' is used instead of 'peer reviewed'</p>

You can generally tell a peer reviewed article just by **looking** at it.

It will be written in **academic** language, have an **abstract** and an extensive **list of references**, and you'll see that the **authors** have **academic credentials**.

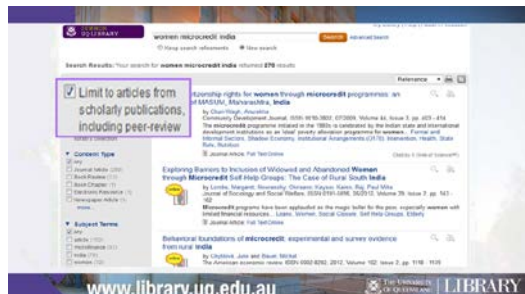
Just be aware that not all articles in peer reviewed journals are **refereed** or **peer reviewed**, for example, **editorials** or **book reviews**

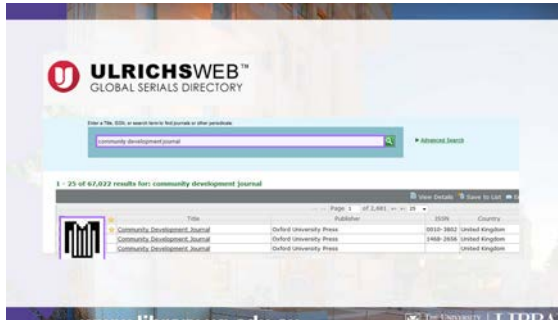
You can search for using **Summon** on the library website
Once you've done your search, use **this checkbox** to **limit** your results to **scholarly journals** and **peer-reviewed articles**

You can also use **databases**.
Most library databases allow you to limit your search to peer reviewed articles.

If you're not sure if a journal is peer reviewed, you can check it in a database called **Ulrichsweb**

You can open **Ulrichsweb** from the Library catalogue.

Enter the **journal title** in the search box and look for the **refereed** icon.
