- ✓ You can add publications from **other Web of Knowledge** databases using the ResearcherID button.

- ✓ **Important:**
 1. **Only** Web of Science records are downloaded into UQ eSpace via ResearcherID.
 2. **Only** Web of Science records are used in the citation metrics in ResearcherID.
 3. You can search the Web of Science **using your ResearcherID** as a search term. This will enable you to do a more complex analysis of your publications and articles that cite your publications.

- ✓ You can **manually add publications** that are not indexed on Web of Knowledge databases using a RIS file upload from EndNote. You can also manually add the publication to EndNote web.

Important: Non Web of Science publications will **not** be included in the citation metrics.

- ✓ **Keeping your ResearcherID up to date**

When your new publications are added to the Web of Science you need to update your ResearcherID publication list.

 - Search the Web of Science for your new publication. Check the box in front of your publication and then click on the ResearcherID button.
 - You may find it useful to set up a **Search Alert** on the Web of Science so that every time one of your publications is added to the Web of Science you will be notified in an email. This will remind you to add the publication to ResearcherID. To set up a Search Alert in the Web of Science – click on the Search History tab after doing an author search for your publications.
 - Adding this publication to ResearcherID will also download it to your eSpace.
