## OTHER LEARNING SUPPORT PROGRAMS

### Peer Assisted Study Sessions (PASS)

**PASS** is a program where students work together to consolidate understanding, reinforce key concepts, and develop effective study strategies. **PASS** consists of weekly one-hour, non-compulsory sessions led by 'Peer Leaders', students who have excelled at the course in the past. Each session lasts one hour and is conducted by two leaders who have recently excelled in the same course at a high level.

Sessions are designed to be informal, interactive and fun. PASS Leaders are happy to help you in the areas students often find difficult, so don't be afraid to ask questions. These sessions are also a great way of meeting people and making new friends. PASS also helps many students adjust quickly to tertiary education.

Each week, a leader attends your lectures and writes a summary sheet

for the sessions, containing the main points you need for the week. One hour per week at PASS can save you many more hours of private study!

PASS is designed to complement lectures, tutorials and textbooks. Attendance is voluntary and optional but highly recommended. More details will be available from the beginning of the semester.
