






Starting on the Library home page click the green “**Login to MyLibrary**” box and enter your UQ username and password.

You can tell **this** one is a **print book** because the copies are listed below. There are **2** copies held in the library. Check that the **title** and **author** match what you need. To find the book in the library first check to see if it's **available** or if not when it's **due back**. Then look to see which library it's in. **This** one is in the **Social Sciences and Humanities library**. Finally, write down the **location** and **call number** so you can find the book on the shelf.
