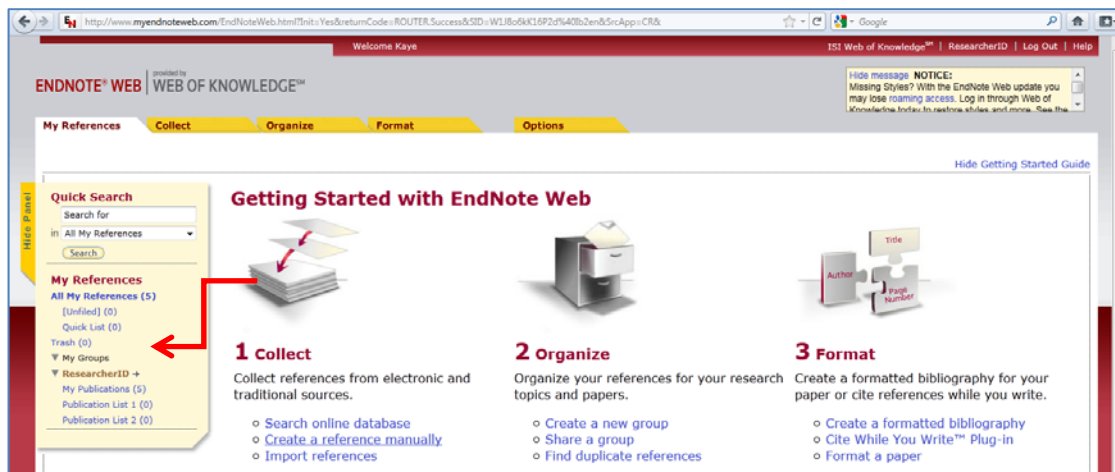


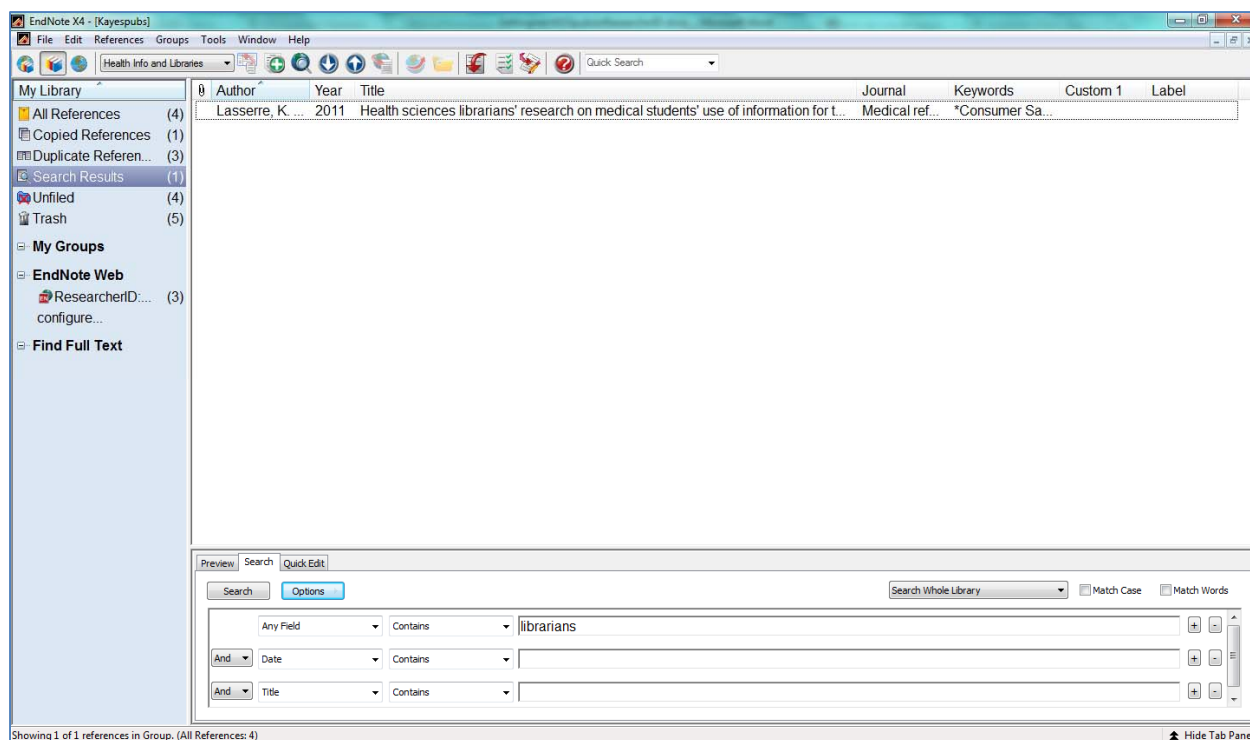


How to get non Web of Science publications into ResearcherID

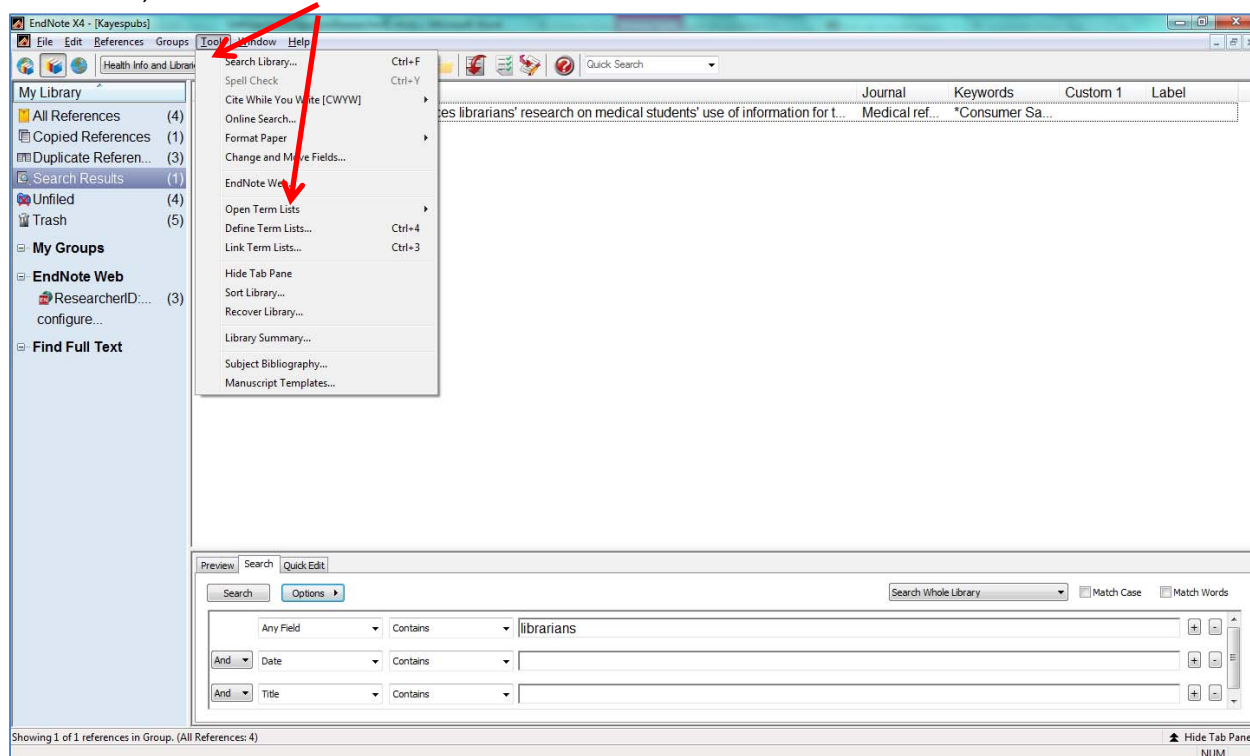
- ✓ [EndNote Web](#) can be used to add non Web of Science publications to ResearcherID. Researcher ID is an Endnote Web library.
 - Login to [Endnote Web](#) using your Researcher ID login details at: <https://www.myendnoteweb.com/EndNoteWeb.html>.
 - Click on **My Publications** to view your current ResearcherID publications.
 - You can now add non Web of Science publications by adding new citations to the My Publications folder in EndNote web.
 - The fastest way to do this is to transfer them from your existing Endnote Desktop library (if you have one).



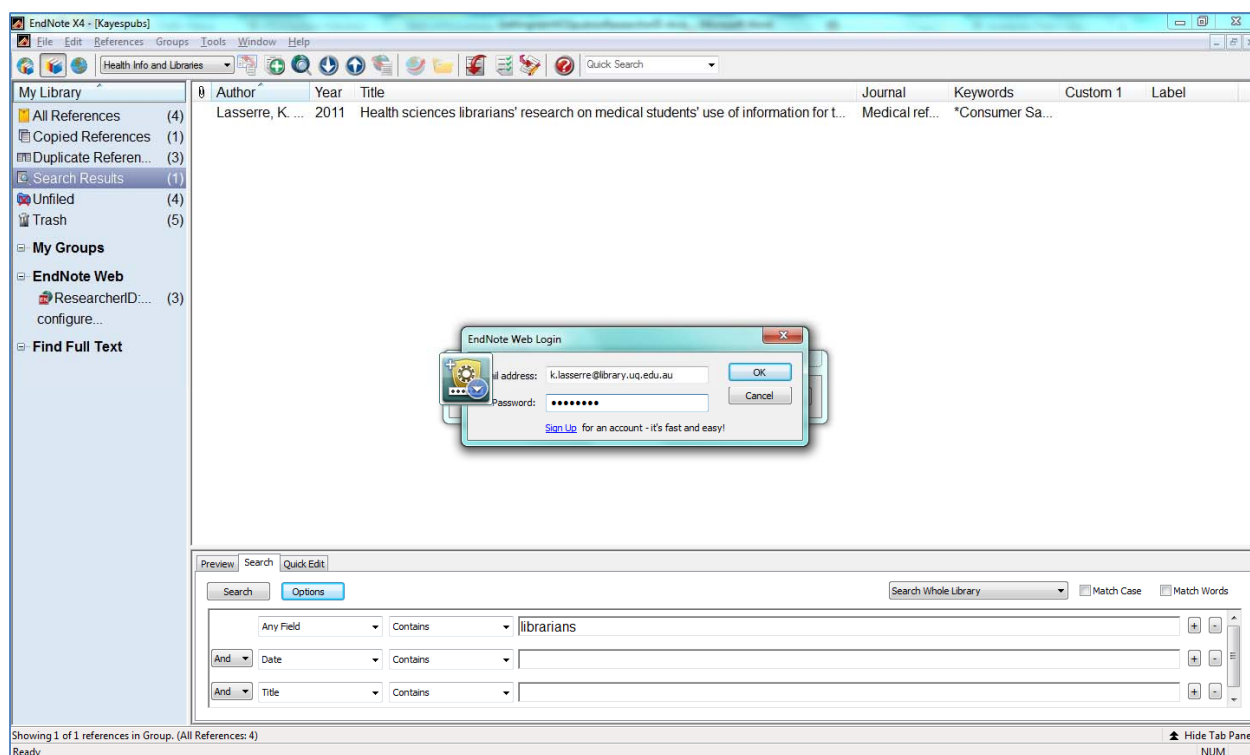
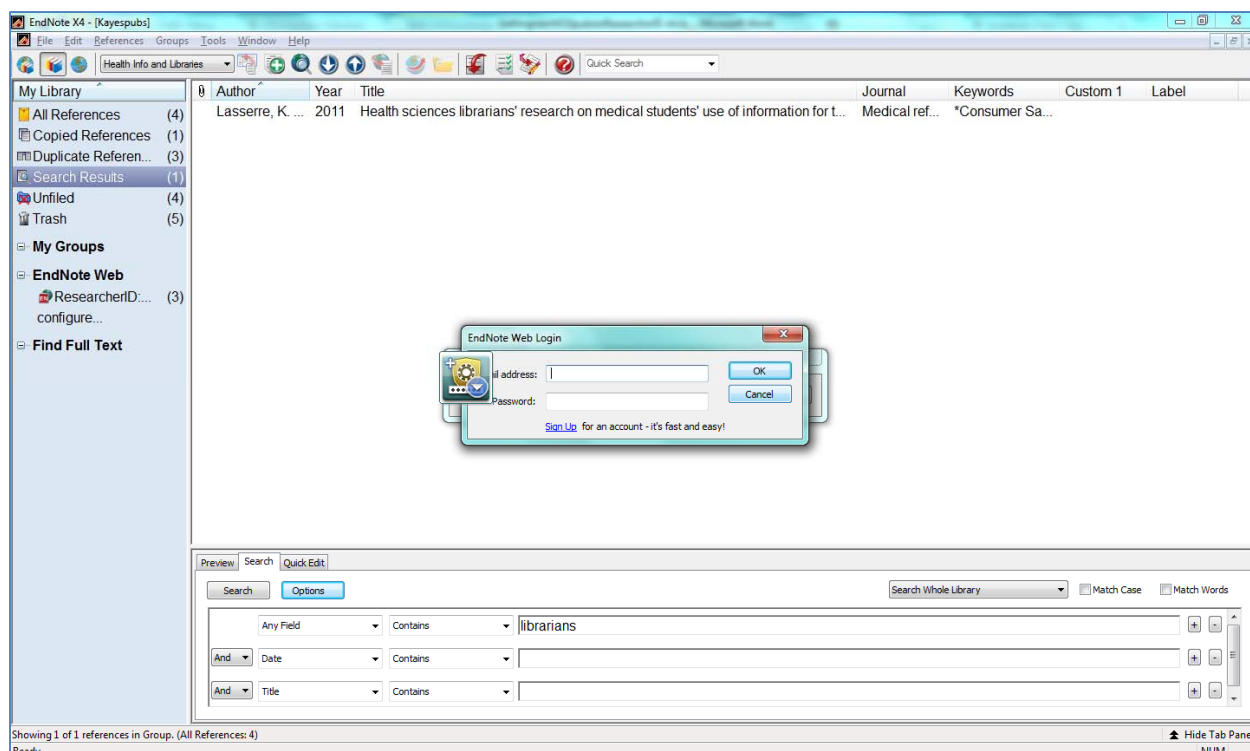
- ✓ Open your Endnote desktop library.



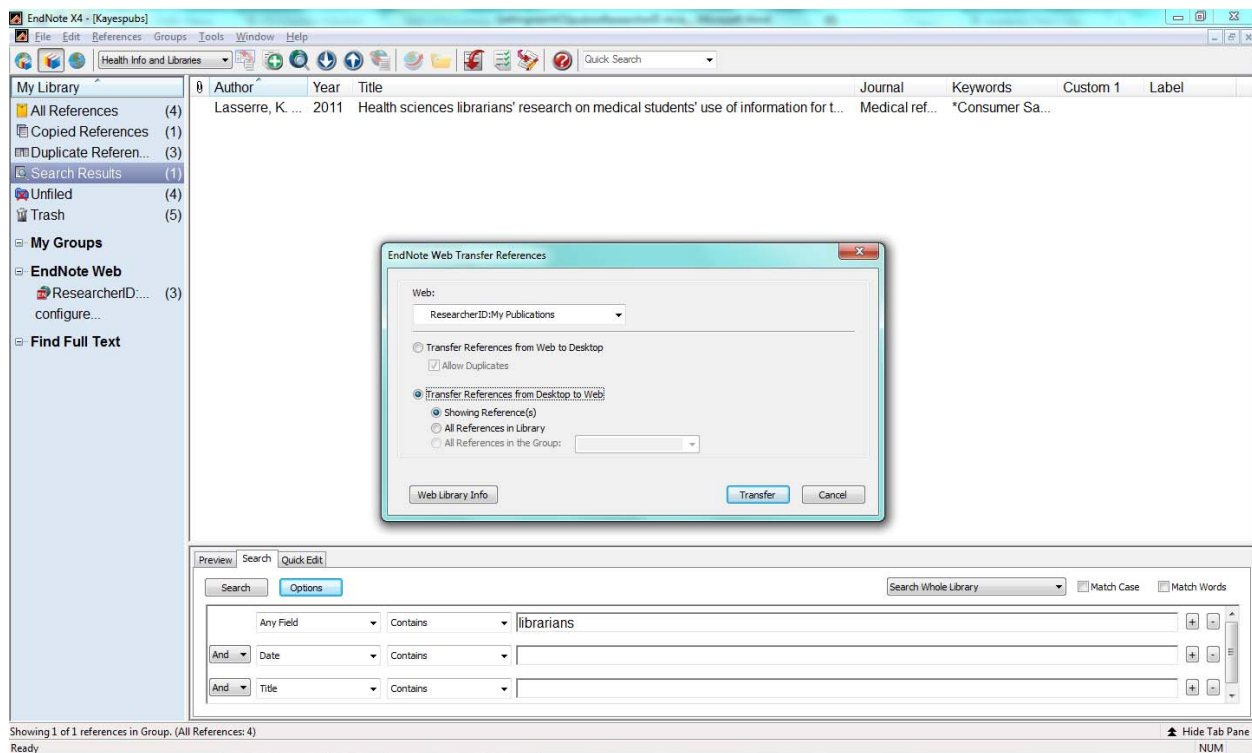
Go to Tools, select Endnote Web



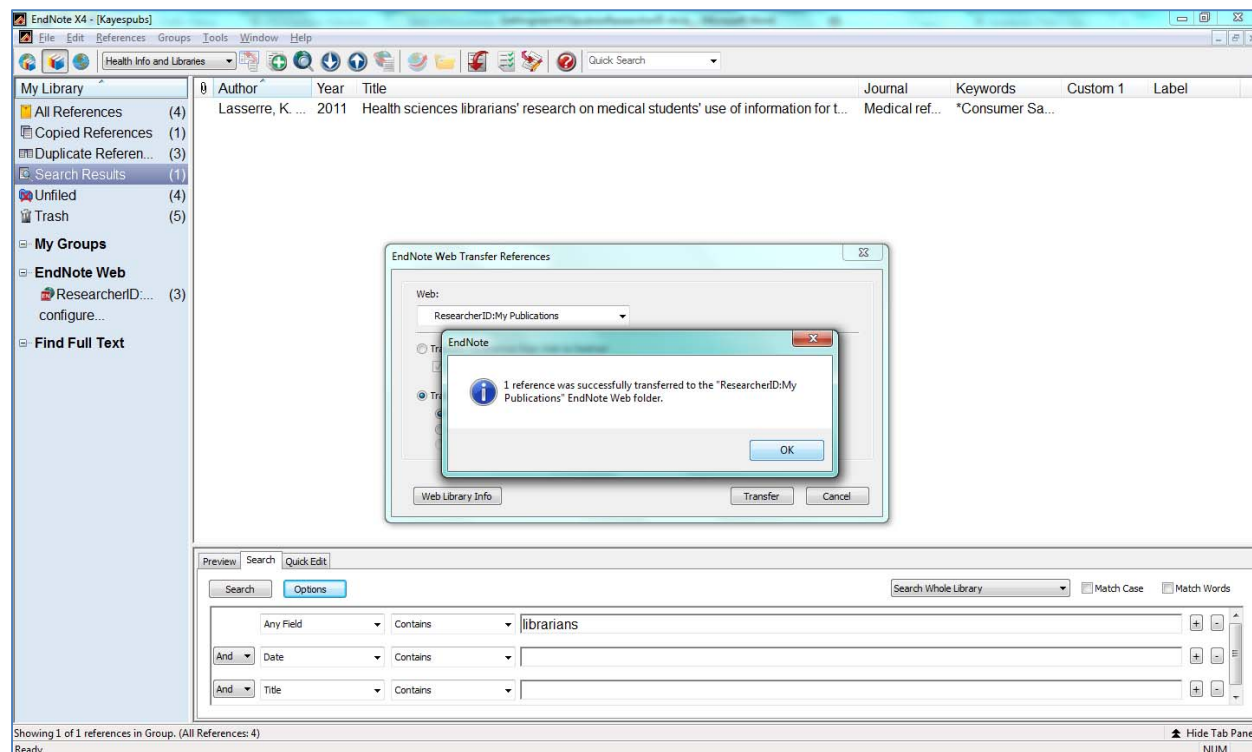
✓ The login window appears, enter your details (as per Researcher ID)



- ✓ At this screen change the option to **Transfer References from Desktop to Web** and select Showing References or whichever is your preferred option.



✓ You should now see the message below.



- ✓ Return to Endnote Web. Refresh the browser so that the new references to appear in My Publications. Click on link to ResearcherID to check publications updated.
