FRYER LIBRARY AWARD AND HONORARY FRYER LIBRARY AWARDS GUIDELINES FOR 2010 APPLICANTS

Thank you for your interest in the Fryer Library Award and Honorary Fryer Library Awards. This information should be of assistance to you in preparing your application.

PLEASE FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE FOLLOWING BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION

Aims

The aims of the Fryer Library Awards are:

- a. To support research on Australian history and Australian culture utilising the collections of the University of Queensland's Fryer Library
- b. To promote The University of Queensland's Faculty of Arts and Fryer Library as Centres of scholarly activity

Eligibility

- a. Fryer Fellowship Awards are available to any scholar from Australia or overseas
- b. Fryer Fellowship Awards will not normally be given to students enrolled in research higher degree programs

Tenure

- a. It is anticipated that the successful applicant will be based at the St Lucia campus of The University of Queensland for a negotiated period of at least three months, with a maximum of six months
- b. The appointment is to be taken up during 2010

Fellowship Award

- a. The amount of the award is \$10,000

Terms and Conditions

- a. Successful applicants will be provided with desk space, computer access, photocopying and full library privileges at the St Lucia campus
- b. The Fellow will be expected to present at least one paper based on his or her work in an appropriate scholarly forum at the University of Queensland and also to address the Friends of Fryer group (<http://www.library.uq.edu.au/fryer/friendsoffryer/>)
- c. Preference will be given to candidates whose projects make substantial use of the Fryer collection and which will result in scholarly publications

- d. The successful applicant will be expected to be based at the University for a negotiated period of between three and six months
- e. Successful applicants will be required to report on their research and published outcomes
- f. Successful applicants will be expected to acknowledge the Faculty of Arts, University of Queensland and the Fryer Library in any publications developed during the Fellowship Award period
- g. Up to two Honorary Fellowship Awards may be announced each year to suitable researchers and writers. These Awards provide successful applicants with desk space, computer access, photocopying and full Library access

Selection

- a. Applications will be considered by a Fryer Library Awards Committee, convened jointly by the University of Queensland Library and Faculty of Arts, comprising representatives from relevant University of Queensland faculties and the Library
- b. Applications will be assessed against the applicant's scholastic achievements, research publications (in relation to opportunity), the strength of the research project proposal itself, and the likelihood of publishable outcomes.
