Biography	Edwin Henry Oribin architect; born Cairns 1927; became registered architect in Queensland in 1953; began partnership with S.G. Barnes in Cairns in 1953, during which time residential and church design was undertaken. After Barnes's death in 1959, Oribin continued his work in Cairns, closing down his office in 1973. Oribin has continued to design significant residential and commercial buildings in Queensland. Martin J Majer collected this series of plans while writing his B.Arch. thesis, <i>E.H. Oribin : the work of a far north Queensland architect</i> (University of Queensland, 1997).
